Participants pay registration fee in roubles in the Russian Federation.

Foreign participants pay registration fee in roubles in cash on arrival to the Conference on September 17 – 19, 2018. Remote foreign participants may participate for free.

The registration fee includes participation in the Conference, participant package, coffee breaks. In this case the participant has paid the registration fee but did not come to the Conference, the registration fee will not be refunded, and the participant package is sent to the participant by regular mail.

ORAL PRESENTATIONS AND POSTERS

Oral presentations. Oral presentations to be presented at the Conference are selected by the Program Committee.

Poster presentations. Posters may be presented by those who participate in person and remotely. All participants planning to take part in the poster session must send a poster file in the .pdf or .ppt, pptx format when registering. All poster files will be posted on the Conference forum, where the Contest Commission members and any Conference participant can ask questions to the authors, poster presentations of those who participate in person are also posted online.

Requirements for posters:

size: 90x120 cm; orientation: vertical; font size must be readable from a distance of 2 m; content: introduction, research goal, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusions, references.

Young scientist contest (poster section). Undergraduate/postgraduate students, master and PhD students and young scientist are welcome to take part in the contest for young scientist reports. Posters are estimated by the Contest Expert Commission. Winners will be selected in each section of the Conference. Winners of the contest will be awarded diplomas and gifts.

PUBLICATION

The book of Conference Proceedings will be published by the beginning of the Conference and included into Russian Science Citation Index. A file containing the materials are to be attached to the online registration form at <http://imbiocom.ru/konf/biomedtech2018/>. The file name must contain “Materials_NAME of the FIRST AUTHOR”. Each research work materials are to be prepared and attached in a .doc, .docx or .rtf format. Please do not forget to enclose a scan of your registration fee receipt. If we do not receive any information about your payment, the materials will not be published. The deadline of material submission is August 25, 2018. Within five working days after submission you will receive a message notifying whether your materials are accepted and included in the Conference Program.

Space Text

Text (three pages or less). Page requirements: left, right, top and bottom margin – 2,5 cm, paper size – A5, portrait orientation, MS Word Normal style, Times New Roman, font size 10 pt, alignment justified, single lining (1,0), indentation 1,0. References in the text are to be given in square brackets [1, 2] in citation order. The list of references is given under the corresponding title “References”. The sources are described according to GOST P 7.0.5-2008.

Selected research works submitted by the authors in the form of oral and poster presentations, will be recommended by the Program Committee of the Conference for publication in the peer-reviewed journal from in the Higher Attestation Commission list.

The results of publications recommended for publication should be transformed into the format of the article and fully comply with the requirements established by the journal editors.

Participants with oral presentations will be provided with a notebook and multimedia projector. The presentation should be in .ppt (MS Power Point) 640x480 or 800x600, or 1024x768 and is to be provided on a USB Flash Drive. The Organizing Committee warns that the demonstrators will not connect computer equipment brought by the speakers to the multimedia projector. The speakers are responsible to provide files with their presentations to our technical staff in advance before their session starts. All the presentations and lectures will be video recorded, and then, with the prior written permission of the speaker, will be available on the website of the Perm State University www.psu.ru.
